Thus it becomes necessary to adopt the same rule during National Competitions with a view to make the participant familiar with changed game format. The Archery Competition during the Senior National Archery Championship for both Recurve and Compound would be conducted as per following :-

**"FITA Round (four distances) followed by the Olympic Round (including sets for Individuals, regular scoring for the team round)"**

### 7.6.5 Set system

7.6.5.1 The winner of a set is the archer which has the highest score of the arrows shot for that set.  
The winner of the set gets two (2) points, If the score is tied both will receive one (1) point.

7.6.5.2 For events depending on the number of arrows per set, there is a maximum number of sets:

- Six (6) arrows/set -> best of three (3) sets. After a minimum of two (2) sets, the athlete with the highest points is declared the winner of the match, when his opponent can no longer tie with the remaining points. If the tie persists after the third (3rd) set, a single arrow shoot off will be shot and the athlete with the arrow closest to the centre will win.
- Three (3) arrows/set -> best of five (5) sets: After a minimum of three (3) sets, the athlete with the highest points is declared the winner of the match when his opponent can no longer tie with the remaining points. If the points are tied after four (4) sets a fifth (5th) set will be shot. If the tie persists after the fifth (5th) set, a single arrow shoot off will be shot and the athlete with the arrow closest to the centre will win.

For 1/64, 1/32, 1/16, 1/8 there will be 6 arrow sets. From the quarter finals, semifinals, finals there will be 3 arrow sets.

For the best of 3 sets you can have the following scenarios (in bold when the match is finished)

After 1st set

2-0; 0-2; 1-1

After 2nd set

**4-0**; 2-2; 3-1; 1-3; **0-4**

After 3rd set

**4-2**; **2-4**; **5-1**; **4-2**; **2-4**; **1-5**; 3-3-> Tie Break

For the best of 5 sets you can have the following scenarios (in bold when the match is finished)

After 1st set

2-0; 0-2; 1-1

After 2nd set

**4-0**; 2-2; 3-1; 1-3; **0-4**

After 3rd set

**6-0**; 5-1; 4-2; 3-3; 2-4; 1-5; **0-6**

After 4<sup>th</sup> set

**7-1**; **6-2**; 5-3; 4-4; 3-5; **2-6**; **1-7**;

After 5<sup>th</sup> set

**7-3**; **6-4**; **4-6**; **3-7**; 5-5-> Tie Break
