for the period

1st July 2009 to 30th April, 2010

Dear Members of the Archery Family

I am greatly honoured to welcome you all at the Annual General Council Meeting of Archery Association of India today, 22nd May 2010.

It is my humble privilege and pleasure to present my report before the General body of Archery Association of India highlighting the achievements and activities of the Association during the period from April 2009 to April, 2010.

The numerous activities that were undertaken by the Association during the period are a clear testimony of the extent to which the plan objectives have been realized. The preceding year witnessed an intensification of AAI activities at all levels.

I wish to place my special thanks and gratitude to **SAHARA India Pariwar** who came forward to join hands with Archery Association of India and gave away cash incentives of Rs.30 lakhs to achievers and promisers. This happens probably for the first time in the history of Indian Spors.

While extending my good wishes for fruitful deliberations in the Annual General Meeting, I wish to put down the key achievement of Indian archery :-

- **India ranked 2nd as Nation in FITA ranking based on World Cup-2009 performance.**
- **Indian Recurve Men team is still sustaining its 2nd position in overall world ranking.**
- **Jayant Talukdar got 1st rank in World Cup-2009 and 4th position in world ranking.**
- **Atanu Das and Seema Verma secured berth for Youth Olympic Games- Singapore.**
- **Deepika Kumari emerges as a “World Champion” in Recurve Cadet Girls Category in Youth World Championship in USA.**
- **Sanjay Boro won Bronze Medal in Cadet Individual Recurve Event in Youth World.**
- **Compound Cadet Boys team won Team Bronze Medal in Youth World**
- **Indian squad returned home with a rich haul of 2 gold, 2 silver and 2 Bronze medals in the 16th Asian Championship – Bali for the first time.**
- **I.R. Sanam won Individual Compound Champions’ Title and his Team won Team Compound Champions’ title in the Asian Championship - Bali.**
- **Compound Women Team and Recurve Men Team grabbed Silver Medals in Bali.**
- **Indian archers gathered altogether 22 Gold, 9 Silver and 8 Bronze medals in five Asian GP Events.**
- **India dominated the South Asian Games-Dhaka by putting total 6 medals in their quiver including all 4 Indv.and Team Golds, 1 Silver and 1 Bronze.**

Our cadets – Deepika Kumar, Sanjay Boro, Atanu Das, S.Jayalakshimi, Harsha Bhardwaj, Ritul Chatterjee, Sudhakar Paswan, Seema Verma proved themselves right as an Assets for the Indian Archery. Archers showed tremendous mettle in their first international tournament bringing one Gold, one Bronze at home. Unluckily, two medals have been missed narrowly.

The achievements conquered by Indian Archers during the events are given as under :-

- **Cadet Girl Individual Recurve “Gold Medal” - Deepika Kumari**

Continuing her brilliant performance in the qualification round scoring 1345 (4th rank) out of 1440 possible points and after getting bye in 1/32 round, Deepika Kumari easily defeated Archers from Germany in 1/16, Australia in 1/8 and USA archer in ¼ match scoring 115 against 104. In the Semis, she had beaten Ms.Jeon H of Korea in a very exciting match (112/108). She overcame a stiff challenge from Russian’s Ms.Tsyrempilova S to claim the Cadet Recurve individual Gold Medal. In the clash of top honour, she pipped the Russian and clinched “**Gold Medal**” by comfortable 6 points margin gathering 115 points Vs 109. She emerged truly as the World Champion. She was consistent throughout the championship.

This was the second time that India won the World Youth title in archery. Palton Hansda won it for the first time in 2006 at Merida (Mexico) by annexing the Junior Compound Individual gold medal in the ninth edition of the world championship.

- **Cadet Boy Individual Recurve “Bronze Medal” - Sanjay Boro**

Sanjay Boro was eliminated in Semi Final rolling three triumph to win 1/32, 1/16, and 1/8. He eliminated Osman Eskici of Turkey in quarterfinal match securing 112 against 101 but went down to Min T (Korean) in Semi Final (117 Vs 106). Finally, he fought with Mr.Smith Ha of Mexico in Bronze Medal match. He crushed Mexican and grabbed Bronze medal by 4 points.

- **Cadet Girls’ Compound Team “Bronze Medal” –Jayalakshmi, Prerna, Nilam**

In a tie-breaking Bronze Medal match, Indian Cadet Girls team comprising of Prerna Bhagat, Jayalakshmi Sarikonda and Nilam Kumari gave a Bronze Medal to India on the penultimate day of the 11th Youth World Championship. They defeated comparatively strong Russian Team (211 Vs 211) in tie breaker. They eliminated Australia scoring 217 Vs 215 but lost to USA with huge margin of 11 points (230 Vs 219).

Other commendable performances are as follows :-

- **Cadet Boys’ Compound Team got 4th position lost their Bronze Medal match against USA.**
- **Cadet Boy’s Recurve Team of Sanjay Boro, Parashan Nath and Mangal Ho ranked 4th loosing Bronze Medal from Italy. They registered two wins against Finland and Mexico.**
- **Junior Girls’ Compound Team consisting of Ashrita Kerketta, Priyanshu Kashhap and Kiran Majhi got 5th position in the event.**
- **Atanu Das and Pawan Xalxo also succeeded to play quarterfinals**

Kapil was selected in the team but could not attend the event due to training schedule at Korea under the Mittal Champion's Trust.

Shri Limba Ram, Shri Lalrem Sanga and Shri Lokesh Chand accompanied the team as Coaches and Shri Shashi Prakash Sharaf attended the event as Sports Analyst.

It is worth mentioning that our Recurve Men Team of Jayanta Talukder, Rahul Banerjee and Mangal Singh Champia displayed their vigorous feat, great tuning and eagerness to win two Gold Medals and one Silver Medal in three world Cups but unfortunately they returned home with empty hands from 4th World Cup-2009 for the first time. They started with win against Ukrain (217 Vs 207) in Pre-quarter final but failed to eliminate Mexico (210 Vs 218) in quarter final. They attained 5th position.

Similarly, Recurve Women team demonstrated good determination in Pre-quarter final against Kazakhastant team. They shot 213 as compared to 200. In quarter final, they went down to Italy by 4 points (215 Vs 219). Indian team stood at 5th.

The performance of both Recurve and Compound Archers in the World Championship was very miserable. It was looked very disgraceful that none of our team except Recurve Men could qualify for the elimination round even.

Only one team win in opposition to Malaysian (217 Vs 207) was registered by Recurve Men team in pre-quarter final. They did not maintain the spirit fighting against China in quarter final and lost. They ranked 7th in the World Championship.

d) 4th Asian Archery Grand Prix Championship-2009

If we thought 2008 was big in terms of Indian team participation in international competitions then 2009 was huge with respect to the International Competition that AAI hosted. We hosted two international championships during the intervening period.

It is a matter of great pride and satisfaction that Archery Association of India had conducted 4th Asian Grand Prix Archery Championship at Kolkata from 16th to 19th September, 2009. Eye-catching fireworks lit up the evening sky after Prof. Vijay Kumar Malhotra, President, AAI declared the meet open. The short inaugural programme began with a march past by the participating countries followed by performances by Kolkata Police band and a cultural troupe. The Union Minister of State for Tourism, Mr. Sultan Ahmed was the Chief Guest on Closing ceremony who distributed the medals among others.

The Asian GP was attended by nine countries - Bangladesh, Iran, Northern Ireland, Scotland, Singapore, Hong Kong, Bhutan, Nepal along with host - India.

Indian archers showed an excellent marksmanship and successfully gathered 7 gold, 1 silver and 3 bronze medals in the Asian GP meet. India made a clean sweep of gold medals in the team championship. Bangladesh followed India at the second place with a medal haul of 1 gold and 1 silver. Scotland was third with 3 silver and 2 bronze medals. Iran was fourth with 2 silver and 3 bronze medals.

India perhaps never had it so good in an Asian Championship. India finished the championship with two gold, two silver and two bronze medals in the 16th Asian Champ– Bali as against one gold, one silver and two bronze medals at the 15th Asian Champ.at Xian, China two years back. The phenomenal successes may be attributed to a large extent to Compound Archers, as out of six medals, four were from compound category.

- **Compound Men Individual “Gold Medal” - Isiah Rajendra Sanam**

Isiah Rajendra Sanam occupied the top slot of the podium by in the men’s compound individual event. He pushed Indonesian Nyoman Puruhito to the silver place with a 106-103. It was indeed an historic day as compound archer never had it so good in the past years since its introduction in the country in early 2000. Sanam ousted Amir Kazempour of Iran (108-108) in a tight quarterfinal and edged out Yong Hee Choi of Korean Archer (114-108) in the Semi-Finals to clear the path for the final. In initial stages, he eliminated two archers of Singapore and his batch-mate, Chinnaraju Srither.

- **Compound Men Team “Gold Medal”- Sanam, Chinna Raju, Ratan Singh**

Winning a gold medal by Indian Compound Men Trio – Sanam, Chinna Raju, Ratan Singh in the Asian Championship created farora in Indian archery. They pulled off two victories against their close opponents-Malaysia (225 Vs 219) and Iran (231 Vs 230).

- **Compound Women Team “Silver Medal”- Jhanu, Namita, Manjudha**

One Silver medal came in the bucket of Indian troop through women’s compound team, comprising Jhano Hansdah, Namita Yadav and Manjudha Soy. The trio lost the final to Korea 215-223. Before the final, they trounced Indonesia (222 Vs 208) in quarter final and Iran in tie breaker Semi Final (215 Vs 215).

- **Recurve Men Team “Silver Medal”- Mangal, Jayanta, Rahul**

The Indian men’s recurve team comprising Rahul Banerjee, Jayanta Talukdar and Mangal Singh Champia lost to Korea in the final at 219-222 and settled for the silver medal.

- **Recurve Men Individual “Bronze Medal”- Jayanta Talukdar**

Fifth-seeded Jayanta Talukdar succeeded to conquer his own country mate Mangal Singh Champia (112-110) in the men’s individual recurve bronze medal play- off. For entering into Semi Final, he won four consecutive elimination matches. He lost to Mr.Chengh Wei Kou of Chinese Taipei in a nerve-wrecking Semi final match by scoring 105 against 106.

- **Compound Women Individual “Bronze Medal”- Manjudha Soy**

Manjudha Soy came up with creditable victory against her compatriot Iranian Seyedeh Halimian 113-111 in the women's individual compound bronze medal play-off. Before this, she upsetted three archers of different countries in elimination round but could not hold her nerve in Semi final and lost to Ms.N. Tinbua of Thailand (110 Vs 116).

There was a disappointment with regard to missing of a Bronze Medal by Women Recurve Team. Rimi Buriuly moved into the quarterfinals where she fell to the top seeded Korean. Chekrovolu too lost to a Korean and Reena Kumari too was a victim of the same Korean girl. Laxmirani Majhi was eliminated by a Chinese in the pre-quarterfinals.

i) 1st Asian Archery Grand Prix Championship -2010

Since the dates of 11th South Asian Games at Dhaka (Bangladesh) 29th January to 9th February, 2010 and 1st Asian Grand Prix at Kuala Lumpur (Malaysia) from 5th to 10th February, 2010 were almost clashing with each other, the Selection Committee of the AAI has decided to field A-Recurve Men and A-Recurve Women Team to South Asian Games in view of the importance of games.

Apart from top 4 compound men and 4 compound women archers, Recurve men and Recurve women those who got 5 to 8 rank in the Selection Trial at SAI, Kolkata from 12th to 18th December, 2009 were assigned to the 1st Asian Grand Prix. The details of Indian archers as follow :-

The South Asian Games proved to be India's gold mine as the regional super power swept all the four Gold Medals in individual as well as team categories of Recurve and Compound divisions besides one Silver and one Bronze. Archery was introduced as a sport in South Asian Games at Colombo in 2006 where India won all the four gold and two silver medals.

Tarundeep Rai and Dola Banerjee emerged the "Individual Champions". India also won both the team gold medals.

Laishram Bombayla Devi won silver in women's individual recurve event and Jayanta Talukdar picked up the bronze medal in the men's event.

k) Invitational CWG Archery Test Event

With a view to test and train our team volunteers, staff and event plan, Archery Association of India with Organising Committee, CWG conducted Invitational CWG Archery Test Event at Yamuna Sports Complex, Surajmal Vihar, Delhi from 8th to 12th March, 2010. The competition was funded by OC, CWG.

It was a really a great experience not only to work and coordinate with OC, CWG and FITA for delivering the best during the Commonwealth Games-2010 by eliminating lapses and weaker areas but also to get our team prepared for the real competition during Commonwealth Games in front of their contenders.

Welsh Archery Association and Scottish Archery Federation have extended their thanks and appreciation for the efficient and effective way by which the archery test event was conducted. All the participating team were highly impressed with the hospitality and full proof security arrangements made during the event.

India fielded all top eight archers in each four categories as a host country. Though it was just a test event, India made a clean sweep of individual and team medals collecting all medals in the recurve section but failed to get a Gold in the compound category.

- **Recurve Archers Performance**

Tarundeep Rai and Deepika Kumari emerged as Individual Recurve Champions by upsetting Chekrovolu Swuro and Kapil in the finals. Deepika Kumari was a revelation and she proved his worth with a gold medal winning performance overcoming big names. Rahul Banerjee and V.Pranitha managed to win Individual Bronze Medals. The biggest disappointment was the performance of Jayanta Talukdar and Mangal Singh in men recurve whereas Dola Banerjee, L.Bomayala Devi and Rimil Buriuly also failed to register their prominent entry in recurve women.

• **Compound Archers Performance**

Malaysian archer won the men's compound individual gold medal defeating Chungda Sherpa who took ultimate Silver. C. Srither took the bronze beating Isaiah Rajender Sanam. Gagandeep went down to Jersey archers and bagged Silver Medal. Both Compound men and women teams grabbed Silver Medals respectively.

National Competitions :

Details of domestic Competitions staged during the period under report are given as under :-

- I) **The 2nd Mini (Recurve, Compound and Indian Round) National Championship** was conducted at Vijaywada (Andhra Pradesh) from 14th to 17th August, 2009 by Andhrav Pradesh Archery Association with the association of Volga Archery Academy. About 190 archers from various State Associations/Units took part in the competition.

- II) **The 32nd Junior (Recurve, Compound and Indian Round) National Champ.** was conducted at Raipur (Chhattisgarh) from 1st to 5th November, 2009 by Chhattisgarh State Archery Association. More than 430 boys and girls competitors along with 63 officials from 25 State Associations/Units participated in the event. The Archers belonging to SPSB, Jharkhand, Assam & W.B. in Recurve, SSCB, Jharkhand, A.P. in Compound and Manipur, Jharkhand, U.P., SSCB and Karnataka in Indian round were dominated.

- III) **The 17th Sahara Senior (Indian Round) National Championship** was conducted at Margao (Goa) from 7-10 January, 2010 under the auspicious of Amatuer Archery Association, Goa. Number of participants including 224 Archers and 62 officials from record number of 38 State Associations/Units broke the previous record of Units participation. SSCB, CRPF, Manipur and Assam impressed with their performance.

- IV) **The 30th Sub-Junior(Recurve, Compound & Indian Round) National Champ.** was organised at Aurangabad, (Maharashtra) from 24th to 28th March, 2010 under the auspicious of Maharashtra State Archery Association. Number of 257 (boys & girls) archers along with 53 team officials from 21 State Associations/Units participated in the event. Performance of SPSB, SSCB, Jharkhand, Assam archers in Re curve whereas archers of Jharkhand, Rajasthan, A.P. and Maharashtra took almost medals in compound. Archers of SSCB, Jharkhand, Assam and UP demonstrated good results in Indian style event.

- V) **The 30th Sahara Senior (Recurve and Compound) National Championship** was Organized at Guwahati (Assam) from April 23 -27, 2010 under the aegis of Archery Association of Assam with a good number of 326 Senior Men and Women renowned Archers with again record number of 38 State Associations/Units. SPSB, SSCB and Indian Railways proved their dominance in Recurve and states of Indian Railway, Maharashtra, Jharkhand, SSCB went away maximum number of medals in compound category.

V) Tribal Competitions

As appraised the members through Secretary General's report in the last General Council Meeting regarding an MOU which was signed between Archery Asson. of India and Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MOTA), Govt.of India for conducting Tribal (men & women) Archery Competitions - Five State level and One National level under the budget provided by MOTA.

On behalf of Archery Association of India, I would like to thank and congratulate all our Organising State Associations/Units, participants, Coaches, Managers, Technical Officials, Volunteers, Scorers who helped a lot in accomplishing the aims and objectives of the association throughout the year.

Miscellaneous Developments and Activities

- **World Ranking**

It is an honour that Indian Archery Team Ranked 2nd as Nation in FITA's World Cup ranking in the year 2009 and awarded the trophy during FITA congress in Ulsan, Korea.

Indian Men Recurve Team sustained their 2nd position consistently second year in the world ranking.

Jayanta Talukdar qualified for World Cup final as ranked 1 in the World and current standing in ranked 4th in the World Cup.

Shri Mangal Singh Champia (15th rank), Shri Rahul Banerjee (18th rank) in recurve men section whereas Dola Banerjee (15th rank) and Rimil Buruily (17th rank) in recurve women section are among the top 20 archers of the world.

The instant ranking of Compound Men team in the world is 15th and Compound Women team possesses 9th rank.

- **Preparation of Indian Archery Team for Commonwealth Games & Asian Games 2010 - Coaching Camps & Trials**

A total number of 64 probables in recurve and compound categories (16 X 4) were selected initially by the AAI for intensive training at SAI, Eastern Centre, Kolkata for the 2010-Commonwealth Games-Delhi under the watchful eyes of competent coaches and supporting staff. The National Coaching Camp was started for selected probables in October, 2008 which is still in progress.

Offering fair chance to 64 probables, Youth World participants, Archers who scored 1300+ in recurve and 1330+ in compound and other archers at his/her own stay and food arrangements, a Selection Trial was conducted at Kolkata from 12th to 18th December, 2009 to trim down the number of probables to 6 core propables and 2 additional archers in each four divisions-Recurve Men, Recurve Women, Compound Men and Compound Women upto November, 2010. 576 arrows(16 X 36 arrows) in 70 Mtrs were provide to shot in the trial.

It has been decided by the Selection Committee on 19th February, 2010 that five Selection Trials for the final selection of 3 members team each in all four categories for Commonwealth Games and Asian Games and 4 members team for World Cup-2010 and other international competitions would be conducted. Cumulative points of all the archers till the 5th Trial would be considered as final to draw rank 1, 2 and 3 who will represent as a

team member in CWG 2010. Rank 4 archer in Recurve Men and Recurve Women will play in the Asian Games. The Minutes of the Selection Committee was uploaded at AAI website and displayed prominently for the accessibility of all.

India is one of the strongest teams among Commonwealth countries in Archery with challenges likely to come from Malaysia, , Australia, Canada, England New Zealand and South Africa. A total number of 8 Gold Medals will be at stake in Archery competition.

Our Indian Recurve archers have been performing brilliantly since 2008 and they should not be satisfied less than Gold alongwith individual medals. Recurve Women team are expected to be placed either in first or second position. Compound Men team had reached a new height in the 16th Asian Games-Bali by winning individual and team Gold Medals. Going by instant form of both compound men and women archers, it has been a struggle for the Gold and they may face stiff challenge from commonwealth countries but there is still enough time for them to pick up.

- **Qualification for Youth Olympic Games - Singapore**

It is a matter of great pleasure that India is among 10 privileged countries to have earned full quota places for the Singapore 2010 Youth Olympic Games at Ogden (Utah), USA. on July 17, 2009. The Games' qualifying tournament offered a maximum of two places, one each in men's and women's section, to each country. India's Atanu Das and Seema Verma stood second and 13th overall in their respective sections to earn India the quota places out of 17 sports available in each category.

The qualification tournament held during the Youth World Championship-USA in which 84 men and 61 women from 42 countries participated.

- **Sahara felicitates India's leading archers**

Members are aware that Sahara India Pariwar, a major business conglomerate and the prime promoter and patron of sports in India joined hands with Archery Association of India to motivate the Archery in the country.

As a part of its commitment, Archery Association of India and Sahara India reviewed the performance of archers of the country during the year 2009-10 and consequently selected 24 archers under the Achievers and Promisers categories for giving cash awards totaling to Rs.30 lakhs. It was certainly occurred for the first time in the Indian Sports.

While giving away cash incentives to archers on April 20, 2010, Mr. Abhijit Sarkar, Head Corporate Communication, Sahara India Pariwar said, "we are proud to be associated with the game of archery and hope the cash award provided to the Achieving and Promising archers would encourage them to perform better and bring glory and laurels to the country. Sahara, under the able leadership of our Chairman and Managing Worker, Saharasri Subrata Roy, has once again set an example in the promotion of sports in India.

- **Coaching Courses and Technical Officials Seminars**

It has been another great period for our coaches, judges and other technical officials as they took ample opportunities during the period. I wish to bring it to the notice of the members :-

- i) **Technical Officials Seminar – Kolkata**

It is a matter of pleasure that Seminar for Technical Officials was conducted at Millennium hostel, Kolkata under the financial support of Organising Committee, Commonwealth Games with an idea to upgrade the knowledge of our TOs who will make their services available to Commonwealth Games Delhi 2010. There were 38 trainees had attended the seminar. The faculties headed by Morten B. Wilmann, Chairman, FITA Judge Committee, Mr.Karim Safai, Technical Delegate for Asian GP, Mr.Rathin Datta, Chairman, Judges' Committee, AAI, Mr.Matsiewdor War Nongbri, FITA International Judge and Dr.H.L.Jindal, Member, Technical Committee, AAI. The seminar had two parts: theoretical and practical and the 4th Asian Grand Prix at Kolkata gave the opportunity to utilize it for Technical officials' practical aspect. The Archery Association of India identified a group of technical officials who are now capable of serving during the CWG 2010.

- ii) **FITA Judges Seminar – Germany**

Consequent on the recommendation of Archery Association of India to Organising Committee, CWG, three AAF Continental Judges – Dr.Ranjan Bhowmik, Shri Promod Chandukar and Shri Indranil Datta have been sent to attend the FITA Seminar at Weisbaden Germany from 23rd to 25th October, 2009 with a view to upgrade their status from Asian Continental to FITA Judges Candidate.

It is pleased to announce that Shri Indranil Datta, who had become a Continental Judge a few months earlier passed out the FITA International Judges Candidate exam out of two others Indian entries appeared in a test.

- iii) **4th FITA World Archery Coaching Seminar – Rome**

A four-days FITA World Archery Coaching Seminar at Rome (Italy) from November 2-7, 2009 has been arranged by International Archery Federation (FITA). The names of Shri Jiwanjot Singh and Shri Gajender Kumar Sharma have been proposed by the AAI to represent India in the Coaching Seminar. Several lectures were given to the participants. A large variety of subjects such as technical coaching, youth development, field archery and equipment were presented. Very enthusiastic feedback has been received from the nominated coaches. The participants were voiceless when they were informed by Shri Gajender displaying the Indian made bamboo bow and arrow that the National record in India at 30 mts. using bamboo bow and arrow is 346 points.

- **Arjuna Award**

Shri.Mangal Singh Champia has been bestowed the ARJUNA AWARD by Smt.Pratibha Patil, Hon'ble President of India at Rashtapati Bhawan, New Delhi on 29th August, 2009 in recognition of his outstanding achievements in the field of Archery. He richly deserves the Arjuna Award for his consistency in performance, dedication, determination, discipline and their sense of duty to bring glory for the country.

Smt. Krishna Ghatak Das (1981), Shri. Limba Ram (1989), Shri. Shyam Lal (1991), Shri. Sanjeeva Kumar Singh (1992), Smt.Dola Banerjee (2006), Shri. Tarundeep Rai (2006) and Shri Jayanta Talukdar (2007) were the other Arjuna Awardees in previous years.

- **Website**

Upward visitors' trend towards our website at www.indianarchery.info has encouraged us to keep the improvement process continue with more information and data for the accessibility of the archery loving people.

Conclusion

The association had received generous support and sustained efforts from the President, AAI, the Executive Members, the Member Associations, especially those who took responsibility to hold National and tribal competitions and from our pioneer feeder centers like Army Sports Institute- Pune, TATA Archery Academy- Jamshedpur and Mittal Champions' Trust-Mumbai. My special mention to technical officials, coaches and volunteers. All did a superb job and I wish to place on record my sincerely thanks and appreciation to all of you for your constant cooperation, assistance, time and efforts. But I extend my biggest thanks to the Archers who performed so magnificently in majority of the international competitions and gave a chance to celebrate an another successful year. You shot with great zest, zeal and skill overcoming the pressures of the Games.

Although this report is about the past, we have continued to prepare it for the future. All eyes are focused on the 'Commonwealth Games' to be hosted by India in October this year. The importance of the hours is to prepare hard our archers to perform credibly in terms of winning much larger number of medals than ever before with a view to enhance India's prestige as the host country.
