I am directed to intimate member associations about allotment of National Archery Championships - 2010 for your information and taking action :-

- 1) 34th Junior (Recurve, Compound and Indian Round) National Archery Championship has been allotted to Archery Association of Meghalaya to host at Shillong (Meghalaya) from 4-9 December, 2011 (inclusive of arrival and departure days).
- 2) 19th Sahara Senior Indian Round National Archery Championship will be conducted at Imphal (Manipur) from 22-26 December, 2011 (inclusive of arrival and departure days). The event would be conducted under the auspices of Manipur Archery Association.
- 3) 32nd Sahara Senior (Recurve and Compound) National Archery Championship is tentatively be held at JRD TATA Sports Complex, Jharkhand from 25th to 30th January, 2012 (inclusive of arrival and departure days). The confirmation about firm dates from organizers is yet to come.
- 4) Decision on allotment of 32nd Sub-Junior and 4nd Mini National Championship-2010 would be taken in the General Council Meeting being held on 2nd October, 2011 at New Delhi.

Please go through the under mentioned guidelines on new age groups which will be implemented this years' Sub-Junior and Junior National Championship-2010 and onwards in the lines of rules changed by FITA :-

- a) An Archer may participate in a Sub-Junior National Championship when the competition takes place upto and in the year of his 17th birthday. For 2011, this means anyone born on 1st January, 1994 or later is eligible to participate in Sub-Junior National.
- b) An Archer may participate in a Junior National Championship when the competition takes place upto and in the year of his 20th birthday. For 2011, this means anyone born on 1st January, 1991 or later is eligible to participate in Junior National.

Presidents/Secretaries of all member associations/units must ensure that

- i) Please ensure that entry (by name) of your team participation should be reached to the responsible State Association/Unit and Archery Association of India at least 15 days before the commencement of the events. Preliminary Entry Form be sent one month prior to the event positively.
- ii) Archer who already got ID Card must carry the ID Card with him/her during all the National Championships. The ID must be shown to the Director of Competition/Chief Scorer prior to the commencement of the event for verification. In case of new entry, the attached Registration Form must be filled up(duly signed & stamped in by respective President/Secretary of State Association/Unit) and to be presented to the Director of Competition/Chief Scorers prior to the commencement of the event.
- iii) Proof of age should be submitted along with Registration Form by producing an attested copy of Certificate issued by Municipal Corporation or Gram Panchayat or an attested copy of Matriculation Certificate. Certificate should be issued either in English or Hindi. In case of other regional language, attested supporting document is required to be attached. Guidelines to this effect have been circulated a number of times to the units.
- iv) Bring two flags (size 6" X 4")for march past and hoisting at the venue of the Championships and coloured passport size photographs of participants.
