You will be pleased to know that Archery Association of India is going to organise **Judges and Technical Officials' Seminars at Chandigarh from 15th to 17th April, 2019** during the NTPC National Ranking Archery Tournament as per the details given below:-

Objective/Scope

Select and train willing candidates supported by their member State Archery Associations/Associate Members for awarding the National Judges' Accreditation.

Venue

Auditorium, Punjab University, Chandigarh

Dates

Seminar will start on 16th April, 2008 (at 10.00 AM) and will conclude on 17th April, 2008 (at 5.00 pm). Participants are required to report at Chandigarh one day prior to the Seminar, ie 15th April and may either depart on 17th April (evening) or 18th April (before noon).

Examination & Language

Seminar will be concluded with an examination in English language only. The participants passing the examination will obtain the status of "AAI National Judge". Seminar will be conducted in both English and Hindi languages for the convenience of the members.

Eligibility conditions

Following candidates are entitled to attend the Seminar:-

- Maximum two (2) candidates from each State/Associate Members, duly recommended by respective President/Secretary of the member. Northern neighbouring States like Delhi, Haryana, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Rajasthan are eligible to recommend a maximum of three (3) candidates for the seminar.
- Archery Background and must have basic knowledge of Archery & Archery rules
- Age must be below 40 years
- Proficiency in English language
- Willing participant is required to submit an undertaking that he/she shall officiate at least two National Competitions/National Trials/Departmental Competitions in a year to be conducted by Archery Association of India or under the control of Archery Association of India.
