

## Selection Trial Criteria and Procedure for Senior Compound Indian Team For World Cups

**Venue** : SAI, Sonapat

**Dates** : 29<sup>th</sup> February to 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2020

### **Selection Process**

**Event 1:** All Archers will be required to shoot 2 x 50m for Compound Men & Women. The top 32 Archers in each category will proceed to shoot another 2 X 50. Top 12 Archers (after 4 X 50 mtrs) in each category will proceed to Event-2.

### **Points System for Event-1**

**Qualification Round** - Following the completion of 4 x 50m round, a ranking of archers will be made. Top 12 Compound men & women archers will be awarded points as mentioned below: -

In case of tie in Qualification Round, World Archery rules will be applied to break the tie which says: -

- The count of X +10 will be taken into account. If the tie persists the count of X will be considered and in case it still continues, a coin toss will decide the matter.
- In case of tie for the last position
  - i) The involved archers will shoot a single arrow to determine the winner.
  - ii) If both archers score an X on their first shoot-off arrow, then the match would be considered a tie and a second off arrow will be needed to resolve the matter.
  - iii) If the score is still the same, the arrow closest to the centre of the target face shall resolve the tie and if the distance is the same, successive single arrow shoot offs, until the tie is resolved.

## **Selection Trial Criteria and Procedure for Senior Compound Indian Team For World Cups**

**Event 2** - Archers qualified for Event 2 will be drawn to face each other in round robin format.

A win in each match gives an archer +1 point and a loss 0 point.

In addition of the above, following Bonus Points and Penalty points will be awarded: -

<b>Category</b>	<b>Bonus Point</b>	<b>Penalty</b>
Compound Men	0.25 bonus point for a 149 or above score in a match	An Archer is penalized by 0.25 point, if they score 140 or below in a match
Compound Women	0.25 bonus point for a 147 or above in a match	An Archer is penalized by 0.25 point, if they score 138 or below in a match

### **Points System for Event-2**

Following the completion of round robin matches with addition of bonus points and deduction of penalty points, a ranking list of 1 to 12 will made and awarded points as mention below: -

In case of tie in Round Robin match, World Archery rules will be applied to break the tie which says:-

- The involved archers will shoot a single arrow to determine the winner.
- If both archers score an X on their first shoot-off arrow, then the match would be considered a tie and a second off arrow will be needed to resolve the matter.
- If the score is still the same, the arrow closest to the centre of the target face shall resolve the tie and if the distance is the same, successive single arrow shoot offs, until the tie is resolved.

### **Tie in Total Points Event 2**

In case tie in total points, the involved archers will shoot set of three arrows and the following order will be taken into consideration:

- 1) The number of points, if tied
- 2) Arrow closest to the centre, if still tied the second arrow (or third) closest to the centre shall determine the winner.

## **Selection Trial Criteria and Procedure for Senior Compound Indian Team For World Cups**

### **Final Team Selection World Cup Stage - 1 & 2**

Total points earned in Event 1 and Event 2 will be added to make final list.

In case tie in total points, the involved archers will shoot a set of three arrows and the following order will be taken into consideration:

- 1) The number of points, if tied
- 2) Arrow closest to the centre, if still tied the second arrow (or third) closest to the centre shall determine the winner.

### **Selection of Team**

Top 4 Archers (Rank 1 to 4) will be selected as team 'A' and next four archers (rank 5 to 8) will be selected as team 'B'. Archers ranked 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> may be kept in stand by for any unforeseen circumstances.

Team 'A' and Team 'B' will be sent to following Competition

<b>Competition</b>	<b>Team</b>
World Cup Stage 1 - Guatemala City	Rank 5 to 8 as Team 'B'
World Cup Stage 2 - Shanghai, China	Rank 1 to 4 as Team 'A'
