

Selection Trial Criteria and Procedure for Junior Indian Team For Asia Cup (Recurve and Compound)

Selection Process

Event 1 : All Archers will be required to shoot 2 X 70m for Recurve & 2 X 50m for Compound. Top 24 Archers in each category will proceed to shoot another set of 2 X 70m for Recurve & 2 X 50m for Compound. Top 12 in each category will proceed to Event-2.

Points System for Event-1

• **Qualification Round** - Following the completion of 4 x 70m for Recurve & 4 X 50m for compound, points will be awarded as mentioned below:-

In case of tie in Qualification Round, World Archery rules will be applied to break the tie which says: -

- The count of X +10 will be taken into account. If the tie persists the count of X will be considered and in case it still continues, a coin toss will decide the matter.
- In case of tie for the last position
 - i) The involved archers will shoot a single arrow to determine the winner.
 - ii) If both archers score a 10 (Recurve) or X (compound) on their first shoot-off arrow, then the match would be considered a tie and a second off arrow will be needed to resolve the matter.
 - iii) If the score is still the same, the arrow closest to the centre of the target face shall resolve the tie and if the distance is the same, successive single arrow shoot offs, until the tie is resolved.

Event 2 - Archers qualified for Event 2 will be drawn to face each other in round robin format.

A win in each match gives an archer +1 point and a loss 0 point.

Points System for Event-2

Following the completion of round robin matches, a ranking list of 1 to 12 will be made and awarded points as mentioned below : -

6	3.5	12	0.5

In case of tie in Round Robin matches, World Archery rules will be applied to break the tie which says

- The involved archers will shoot a single arrow to determine the winner.
- If both archers score a 10 (recurve) or X (compound) on their first shoot-off arrow, then the match would be considered a tie and a second off arrow will be needed to resolve the matter.
- If the score is still the same, the arrow closest to the centre of the target face shall resolve the tie and if the distance is the same, successive single arrow shoot offs, until the tie is resolved.

Tie in Total Points Event 2

In case tie of total points, the involved archers will shoot a set of three arrows and the following order will be taken into consideration:

- 1) The number of points, if tied
- 2) Arrow closest to the centre, if still tied the second arrow (or third) closest to the centre shall determine the winner.

Final Team Selection

Total points earned in Event 1 and Event 2 will be added to make final ranking.

In case tie of total points, the involved archers will shoot a set of three arrows and the following order will be taken into consideration:

- 1) The number of points, if tied
- 2) Arrow closest to the centre, if still tied the second arrow (or third) closest to the centre shall determine the winner.
