

Selection Procedure for World Cup Stage – 4 Recurve & Compound

Event 1 – Qualification Round

All Archers will shoot 2 x 50 mtrs for Compound & 2 x 70 mtrs for Recurve division. The top 24 Archers in each category will proceed to shoot another set 2 x 50 mtrs for Compound & 2 x 70 mtrs for Recurve division. In case tie between ranked 24 or 25, the involved archers will shoot a single arrow shoot-off shall determine the winner.

Summing up scores of 4 x 50 mtrs in Compound & 4 x 70 mtrs in Recurve division, top 8 Archers after in each category will proceed to Event-2. In case tie between ranked 8 or 9, the involved archers will shoot a single arrow shoot-off shall determine the winner.

Event 2 – Round Robin (8 Archers)

A win in each match gives 1 point, loss zero point and a tie $\frac{1}{2}$ point to each archer (there will not be any tie breaking in these round robin matches).

Based on the points earned by the Archers in Event 2 the top archer will be selected for the team and the bottom one will be eliminated.

In case tie in total points, the involved archers will shoot a single arrow shoot-off to determine the winner.

Event 3 - Round Robin (6 Archers)

The details are same as in Event 2 with a difference that it will involve six archers instead of eight.

Based on the points earned by the Archers in Event 3 the top archer will be selected for the team and the bottom one will be eliminated.

Tie if any will be resolved as indicated earlier.

Event 4 - Round Robin (4 Archers)

The details are same as in Event 2 or 3 with a difference that it will involve only four archers.

Based on the points earned by the Archers in Event 4 the top archer will be selected for the team and the bottom one will be eliminated.

Tie if any will be resolved as indicated earlier.

Event 5 – Best of 3 Matches (2 Archers)

The remaining 2 archers from Event – 4 will play the best of 3 matches. In case of a tie, in any match a single arrow shoot-off shall determine the winner. The winner of the Best of 3 Matches will be selected.
