

# **Selection Procedure for Recurve**

**25<sup>th</sup> January, 2019**

**Event 1** – All recurve archers will be required to shoot 2x70m. Top 96 in Recurve Men & Top 64 in Recurve Women will proceed to play Event – 2

**Event 2** – Archers qualified for Event 2 will be required to shoot 2x70m. After summing score of 4x70m, Top 64 in Recurve Men & Top 48 in Recurve Women will proceed to play Event - 3

**26<sup>th</sup> January, 2019– Rest Day**

**27<sup>th</sup> January, 2019**

**Event 3** – Archers qualified for Event 3 will be required to shoot 2x70m. After summing score of 6x70m, Top 32 in Recurve Men & Top 32 in Recurve Women will proceed to play Event - 4

**Event 4** – Archers qualified for Event 4 will be required to shoot 2x70m. After summing score of 8x70m, Top 24 in Recurve Men & Top 24 in Recurve Women will proceed to play Event –5.

**28<sup>th</sup> January, 2019**

**Event 5** – Archers qualified for Event 4 will be required to shoot 4x70m. At the end of Event-5, the total score of each archer will be calculated (Event 1 to 5 or 12 X 70m) and the highest and lowest 36 shot scores will be eliminated. Top 12 Recurve Archers in both men and women category will proceed to Event- 6.

In case of tie in total points, the involved archers will shoot a set of three arrows and the following order will be taken into consideration:

- 1) The number of points, if tied
- 2) Arrow closest to the centre, if still tied the second arrow (or third) closest to the centre shall determine the winner.

**29<sup>th</sup> January, 2019**

**Event 6** – Archers qualified for Event 6 will be drawn to face each other in round robin format. A win in each match gives an archer +1 point and a loss 0 point. In case of a tie in a match, there will be a single arrow shoot-off to determine the winner.

In case of tie in total points, the involved archers will shoot a set of three arrows and the following order will be taken into consideration:

- 1) The number of points, if tied
- 2) Arrow closest to the centre, if still tied the second arrow (or third) closest to the centre shall determine the winner.

# **Selection Procedure for Compound**

## **26<sup>th</sup> January, 2019**

**Event 1** – All compound archers will be required to shoot 2x50m. Top 96 in Compound Men & Top 64 in Compound women will proceed to play Event – 2

**Event 2** – Archers qualified for Event 2 will be required to shoot 2x50m. After summing score of 4x50m, Top 64 in Compound Men & Top 48 in Compound Women will proceed to play Event - 3

## **27<sup>th</sup> January, 2019**

**Event 3** – Archers qualified for Event 3 will be required to shoot 2x50m. After summing score of 6x50m, Top 32 in Compound Men & Top 32 in Compound Women will proceed to play Event - 4

## **28<sup>th</sup> January, 2019**

**Event 4** – Archers qualified for Event 4 will be required to shoot 2x50m. At the end of Event-4, the total score of each archer will be calculated (Event 1 to 4 or 8X50m) and the highest and lowest 36 shot scores will be eliminated.

In case tie in total points, the involved archers will shoot a set of three arrows and the following order will be taken into consideration:

- 1) The number of points, if tied
- 2) Arrow closest to the centre, if still tied the second arrow (or third) closest to the centre shall determine the winner.
